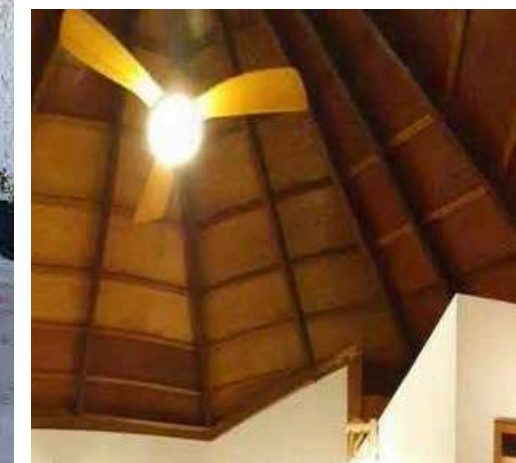
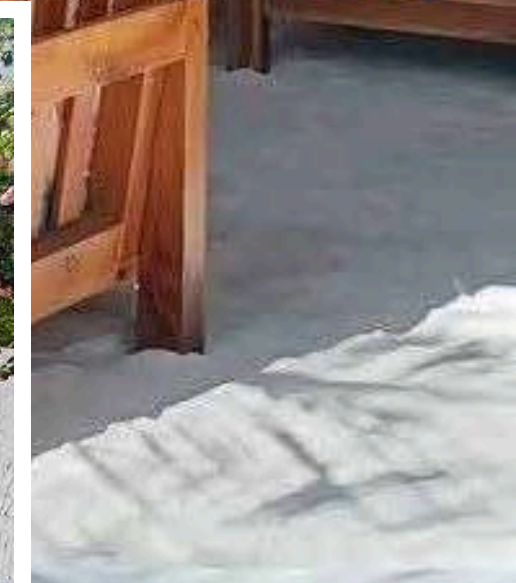
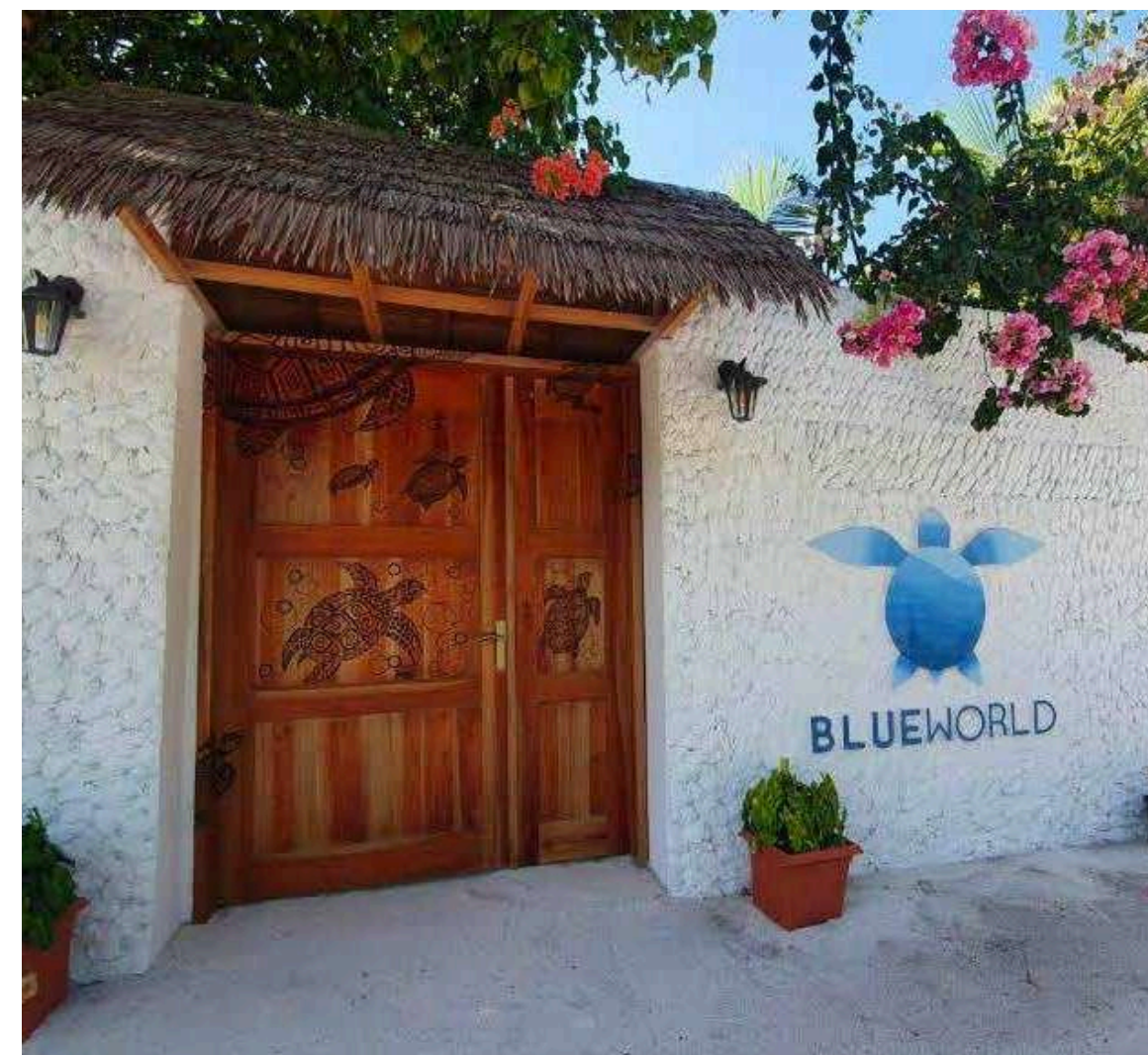

HANIFARU BAY

Hanifaru Bay is a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve located in the Baa Atoll of the Maldives and is widely regarded as one of the greatest snorkeling experiences on the planet. This small, horseshoe-shaped bay is world-famous for hosting the largest known gatherings of Manta Rays and Whale Sharks, making it a truly once-in-a-lifetime destination.

During the southwest monsoon season (May to November), plankton-rich currents funnel into the bay, drawing in dozens – and sometimes hundreds – of Manta Rays that glide gracefully through the water in a breathtaking feeding frenzy. Snorkeling alongside these gentle giants, with wingspans reaching up to 5 metres, is an awe-inspiring experience that words can barely describe.

The bay is strictly protected, with limited daily visitor numbers to preserve its pristine ecosystem, making your visit both exclusive and responsible. Whether you are a first-time snorkeler or a seasoned ocean lover, Hanifaru Bay promises to leave you spellbound.



SANDBANK VISIT

Imagine stepping onto a pristine strip of white sand in the middle of the Indian Ocean, with crystal-clear turquoise water stretching as far as the eye can see. GENERAL INFORMATION ABOUT MALDIVES FOR VISITORS



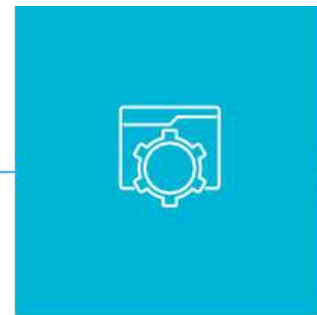
ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Passport should have a minimum validity of 6 months on the date of entry into the Maldives.



VISA

You will get a 30-day Visa free of charge on arrival to the Maldives.



CUSTOMS RULES

The goods that can be brought into and outside Maldives are subject to strict rules. Please declare anything that might be prohibited or subject to tax or duty. It is illegal to bring anything deemed contrary to Islam.



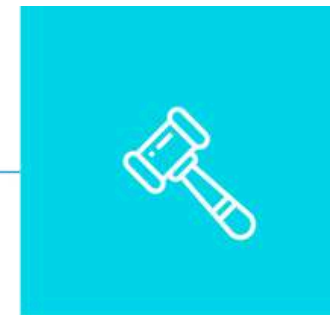
ALCOHOL

Alcoholic Drinks are only available in resort islands and safari boats (Liveaboards). Please do not carry alcohol from resorts or safari boats to local islands (Inhabited islands). Punishments can go up to arrest and deportation for possession of alcohol or being under the influence of alcohol on a local island.



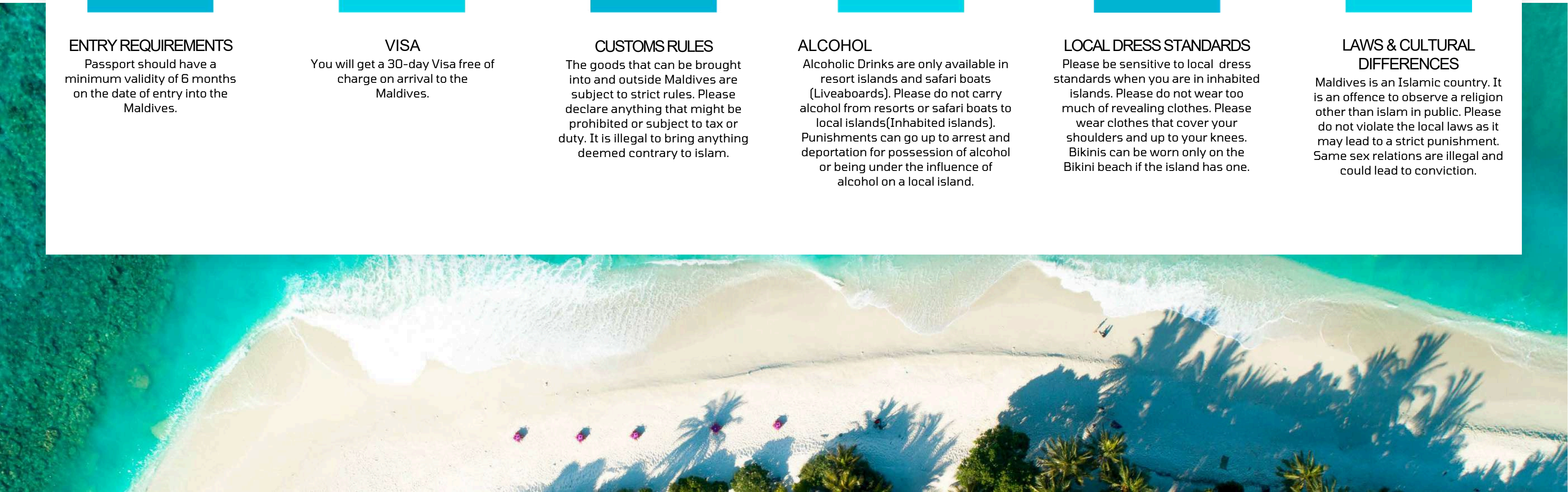
LOCAL DRESS STANDARDS

Please be sensitive to local dress standards when you are in inhabited islands. Please do not wear too much of revealing clothes. Please wear clothes that cover your shoulders and up to your knees. Bikinis can be worn only on the Bikini beach if the island has one.



LAWS & CULTURAL DIFFERENCES

Maldives is an Islamic country. It is an offence to observe a religion other than Islam in public. Please do not violate the local laws as it may lead to a strict punishment. Same sex relations are illegal and could lead to conviction.
